

Coverage of Casgevy and Lyfgenia for Sickle Cell Disease requires Prior Authorization

Sickle cell warriors that are 12 years old or older may qualify for cell and gene therapy treatment at certain specialized centers. There is a process that your doctor must follow to get this gene therapy treatment approved.

Prior Authorization process

A request must be submitted by your doctor. This request will have your medical records, labs and testing. Then a Health Plan medical director will then review your records to see if you would benefit from the treatment.
